



## **HOCKEY NL – HIGH PERFORMANCE PROGRAM (HPP) SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION**

### **GOAL OF THE PROGRAM:**

To identify the best players in each respective age category and expose them to a high level of competition and coaching. With each the male and female programs, the goal is they will continue through the HPP process and have the opportunity to compete with Team Canada in National and World competitions.

### **WHAT TEAMS ARE INVOLVED IN THE HIGH PERFORMANCE PROGRAM?**

- Male Under 14, Male Under 15, Male Under 16
- Female Under 16, Female Under 18

### **WHAT IS THE PROCESS, WHERE DO THE TEAMS COMPETE?**

From the summer camp, a team of 20 players (12F, 6D, 2G) from each age group are selected. This group of players will attend the Atlantic Challenge Cup (ACC) which is a tournament featuring Provincial teams from New Brunswick, PEI and Nova Scotia. The ACC takes place over Thanksgiving weekend (Thursday-Monday).

### **WHAT IS THE OUTLINE OF THE SUMMER CAMP?**

This years summer camp will be a bit different than normal. Players will only be provided on and off ice sessions. Everything else is on the parents/ guardians to look after (hotels, meals transportation etc). There is a block of rooms at the Albatross Hotel and Sinbad's Hotel & Suits under the following booking titles for each group if you wish to use:

- Hockey F U16 & U18 Aug 9-12
- Hockey M U14 & U15 Aug 13-16
- Hockey M U16 Aug 17-20

  - Cost \$109 single, double, triple or quad

The camp will consist of 4 practice, 3 or 4 games and 2 goalie sessions along with various off ice sessions leading into camp and then during camp in Gander.

- Female Under 16 & Female Under 18: August 9-12 (Gander)
- Male Under 14 and Male Under 15: August 13-16 (Gander)
- Male Under 16: August 17-20 (Gander)

### **MEDICAL FORM INFORMATION:**

Player medical information will be collected via online through a Hockey Canada registration system. The links will be sent to all participants prior to the camp to complete. The medical form must be completed prior to the players first ice session.

## **WHAT IS THE COST FOR SUMMER CAMP?**
