

**Job Title:** Support Staff  
**Organization:** Hockey NL High Performance Program  
**Reports To:** Head Coach/Director of Operations

**Outline/Requirements:**

- Must experience in coaching/working with high level hockey players;
- Assist with set-up at summer camp;
- Manage a team during summer evaluation camp including:
  - Bench during camp evaluations
  - Off ice programming
  - Transport players to/from the facilities
  - Complete room checks
  - Ensure players adhere to schedule
  - Ensure players adhere to appropriate behaviour while representing Hockey NL
- Demonstrate commitment;
- Must be available for team and travel commitments;
- Must possess ability to work towards objective of a program by being an integrated part of the team;
- Must adhere to and abide by Hockey NL procedures;
- Must have strong organizational abilities;
- Must have basic understanding of IT programs such as Microsoft Teams, Word, and Excel programs;
- Must have ability to adapt to coaching position(s) designated by Head Coach;
- Must assist in goalie sessions under direction of Goaltender Coach
- Must have ability to work in a team setting;
- Must have ability to take instruction, and perform tasks provided by Head Coach;
- Must have ability to evaluate players and provide constructive feedback;
- Must be able to select goaltenders for the best possible team without bias;
- Must have ability to organize and execute goalie sessions by preparing practice plans;
- Must be able to multi-task, balancing coach duties with on and off ice people management skills;
- Must assist Support Staff as required;
- Must attend all team meetings/conference calls and camps in person;
- Must have ability to work in high pressure situations; and
- Must provide/create a plan for team/player(s) to execute.

The support staff position is intended for coaches interested in the High Performance Program and/or looking for additional experience in a high quality hockey environment. Support staff will be assigned to a group for the duration of the camp.
