



HOCKEY NL – HIGH PERFORMANCE PROGRAM (HPP) SPRING IDENTIFICATION CAMP INFORMATION

GOAL OF THE PROGRAM:

To identify the best players in each respective age category and expose them to a high level of competition and coaching. With each the male and female programs, the goal is they will continue through the HPP process and have the opportunity to compete with Team Canada in National and World competitions.

WHAT TEAMS ARE INVOLVED IN THE HIGH PERFORMANCE PROGRAM?

- Male Under 14, Male Under 15, Male Under 16
- Female Under 14, Female Under 16

WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOLLOWING SPRING CAMP?

An average of *44 players will be selected from each respective age group to attend the Provincial Summer Camp in August.

From the summer camp, a team of 20 players (12F, 6D, 2G) from each age group are selected. This group of players will attend the Atlantic Challenge Cup (ACC) which is a tournament featuring Provincial teams from New Brunswick, PEI and Nova Scotia. The ACC takes place over Thanksgiving Weekend- October 10th –13th.

Male Under 16:

The Male Under 16 team will not attend the ACC. They now participate in the Under 16 QMJHL Cup. Teams participating are New Brunswick, PEI, and Nova Scotia. The tournament is also played in Dieppe, NB.

HOW AND WHEN ARE PLAYERS NOTIFIED AFTER THE SPRING CAMP THAT THEY HAVE OR HAVE NOT MADE IT ON TO THE PROVINCIAL SUMMER CAMP?

Rosters will be posted on our website.

- All players will receive an email directing them to the summer camp posted roster on our website.

- Successful players will receive an additional email with 2024 provincial summer camp information.
- *Alternate players will receive an additional email to advise them of their alternate player ranking.
- In a Canada Winter Games year the staff of both Male U16 and Female U18 have the ability to select players to their camp from the groups below.

○ 2 alternates will be selected for each position/division (2F, 2D, 2G), should a current summer camp roster player not be able to attend the summer camp an alternate player will be contacted in order of their ranking.

MEDICAL FORM INFORMATION:

Player medical information will be collected at the arena prior to the start camp.

WHERE DO I FIND THE SCHEDULE, DATES AND LOCATIONS?

All schedules will be emailed to each registered participant, but you can also view certain information by visiting our website.

WHO WILL BE EVALUATING THE PLAYERS AT THE SPRING CAMPS?

Players will be evaluated by coaching staff of the High Performance Program. If needed additional evaluators may be added by HNL to assist coaching staffs.

IS THERE FEEDBACK AT THE SPRING IDENTIFICATION CAMP(S)?

The Spring HPP camp is an 'identification camp' therefore, *no feedback will be provided*. Our coaching staff use this opportunity to evaluate each player game by game with a ranking number. They will use these numbers to determine who is successful in attending the provincial summer camp in Corner Brook.

CAN I KEEP MY JERSEY FROM THE SPRING IDENTIFICATION CAMP?

Yes, players will be given their jersey to have throughout the camp and keep when the spring camp is finished.

HOW MUCH IS THE SUMMER CAMP AND WHEN IS THIS PAYMENT DUE?

CAN I JUST ATTEND THE PROVINCIAL CAMP AND SKIP THE SPRING CAMP?

No. This process begins with the Spring Identification Camp; only successful players at the Spring Camps will be invited to attend the Provincial Summer Camp. Exemptions can be applied for medical and compassionate reasons.

ARE THERE ANY ADDITIONAL COST ABOVE THE SPRING CAMP REGISTRATION FEE? WHAT DOES THIS FEE INCLUDE?

No, there are no additional costs. This fee includes all taxes and online payment processing fees. A HPP branded practice jersey to keep, and minimum (1) practice, (3) game ice times. All goalies will receive 2 goalie sessions in addition to practice/game time. Gatorade & Water table also supplied.
