We Are Coaches: National High Performance 1 Seminar – Calgary, AB

Hockey Canada will be offering a We Are Coaches (women-only) NCCP High Performance 1 Seminar in Calgary, AB.

Capacity for the seminar is 22 women coach delegates.

DELEGATES

Up to 22 High Performance 1 delegates will be accepted for this seminar.

- 16 women coach delegates will be nominated by their respective Members (see nomination procedures and timelines for more information)
 - All delegates are responsible for their own travel.
 - Meals, accommodation, evaluation and clinic content will be covered by Hockey Canada.
- Hockey Canada will allow for up to an additional 6 delegates to be nominated by their Member to also attend.
 - These additional 6 delegates and/or Member will be responsible for covering delegate costs which includes meals, accommodation, evaluation and clinic content (travel subsidy at discretion of Member).

NOMINATION / SELECTION CRITERIA

HIGH PERFORMANCE 1 DELEGATES / APPLICANTS must meet the following requirements:

- A Canadian resident
- Presently fully certified at NCCP Development 1
- Currently coaching at a high-performance level (U15 AAA or above)
- A coach in good standing with their respective Member, U SPORTS, or the Canadian College Athletic Association.

DELEGATE EVALUATION PROCEDURE

All High Performance 1 delegates will be evaluated in the following areas:

Group Leader Evaluation:

During the course of the seminar all delegates will participate in a series of group tasks, develop and conduct on-ice practices and participate in other group and individual tasks. Completion of these tasks in accordance with the expectations clearly outlined at the seminar will permit the delegate to move to the second stage of the evaluation - the written take home examination.

Written Evaluation:

Each delegate who successfully completes the group leader evaluation will be given the opportunity to write a take-home assignment. Successful completion of the assignment in accordance with the expectations outlined at the seminar will permit the delegate to move to the third stage of the evaluation the field assessment.

Field Evaluation:

Each delegate will be evaluated in the field by a qualified evaluator appointed by Hockey Canada.

The field evaluation includes three components:

1. The evaluation of a practice
2. The evaluation of a game
3. An oral examination (Review of yearly plan, objective demonstration of coaching)

These three field evaluation components will take place within a relatively short period of time. The game to be supervised will follow a practice and the oral examination will conclude the field evaluation.

Other requirements:

Each participating delegate must also satisfy the following requirements:

1. Attendance at the National Virtual Delivery (May 23-25, 2025)
2. Attendance at all sessions of the in-person National HP1 seminar (June 26-29, 2025)
3. Complete and enthusiastic participation in all group activities.
