



HOCKEY NL – HIGH PERFORMANCE PROGRAM (HPP) SPRING IDENTIFICATION CAMP INFORMATION

GOAL OF THE PROGRAM:

To identify the best players in each respective age category and expose them to a high level of competition and coaching. With each the male and female programs, the goal is they will continue through the HPP process and have the opportunity to compete with Team Canada in National and World competitions.

WHAT TEAMS ARE INVOLVED IN THE HIGH-PERFORMANCE PROGRAM?

- Male Under 14, Male Under 15
- Female Under 14, Female Under 16

WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOLLOWING SPRING CAMP?

An average 44 players will be selected for Female U14, an average of 34 players will be selected for Female U16. Male U15 will have an average of 44 players, and an average of 66 players will be selected for Male U14 to attend the Provincial Summer Camp.

From the summer camp, a team of 20 players from each age group are selected. This group of players will attend the Atlantic Challenge Cup (ACC) which is a tournament featuring Provincial teams from New Brunswick, PEI and Nova Scotia. The ACC takes place over Thanksgiving Weekend- October 8th – 11th.

HOW ARE PLAYERS NOTIFIED AFTER THE SPRING CAMP THAT THEY HAVE OR HAVE NOT MADE IT ON TO THE PROVINCIAL SUMMER CAMP?

Summer camp selections will be posted on our website.

- Successful players will receive an additional email with 2026 provincial summer camp information.
- Alternate players will receive an additional email to advise them of their alternate player ranking.

WHAT ARE THE DATES OF THE 2026 SUMMER PROVINCIAL CAMPS?

- Male Under 14 and Male Under 15: July 16 - 20th (Corner Brook)
- Female Under 14 & Female U16: July 20 - 24th (Corner Brook)

MEDICAL FORM INFORMATION:

Player medical information will be collected at the arena prior to the start camp.

WHERE DO I FIND THE SCHEDULE, DATES AND LOCATIONS?

All schedules will be emailed to each registered participant.

WHO WILL BE EVALUATING THE PLAYERS AT THE SPRING CAMPS?

Players will be evaluated by coaching staff of the High-Performance Program and the instructors leading the session. If needed additional evaluators may be added by Hockey NL to assist coaching staffs.

IS THERE FEEDBACK AT THE SPRING IDENTIFICATION CAMP(S)?

No, because this is an 'identification camp' there will be ***no feedback provided***. Our coaching staff uses this opportunity to mark each player game by game with a ranking number. They will use these numbers to determine who is successful in attending the provincial summer camp in Corner Brook.

CAN I KEEP MY JERSEY FROM THE SPRING IDENTIFICATION CAMP?

Yes, players will be given their jersey to have throughout the camp and keep when the spring camp is finished.

HOW MUCH IS THE SUMMER CAMP AND WHEN IS THIS PAYMENT DUE?

CAN I JUST ATTEND THE PROVINCIAL CAMP AND SKIP THE SPRING CAMP?

No. This process begins with the Spring Identification Camp; only successful payers at the Spring Camps will be invited to attend the Provincial Summer Camp. Exemptions can be applied for medical, compassionate, and out-of-province reasons.

**ARE THERE ANY ADDITIONAL COST ABOVE THE SPRING CAMP REGISTRATION FEE OF \$290?
WHAT DOES THIS FEE INCLUDE?**

No, there are no additional costs above the \$290.00. This fee includes a HPP branded practice jersey to keep, and a minimum of (1) practice, and (3) game sessions. Gatorade, Water Bottles, and Hydration Snacks will be provided.
